In discussion with Mr. Larizza and Mr. Weinfurter of Winters Industries on July 7, 1972, the following initial production dates were established on Part No. 334004 Cylinder Head Machining Assembly and Part No. 334076 Camshaft Housing Completely Machined.

Dates are predicated on having a purchase order by July 10, 1972.

Fifty (50) pieces of each part by November 15, 1972 off 80% production tooling with no premium cost. Balance of machining would be off temporary setups or sublet.

OR

Fifty (50) pieces of each part off 100% production tooling by January 1, 1973 with no premium cost.

OR

Overtime to meet November 15, 1972 off 100% production tooling - not to exceed \$50,000.00. Overtime cost would be accurately recorded and subject to audit.

It is imperative that we have an early decision on required delivery date of completed parts, so that if parts are required off 100% production tooling by November 15, 1972, an immediate authorization can be made to Winters to cover overtime charges.
